Motion was made by Vice Mayor Murphy and seconded by Commissioner Bauer to allocate from the General Fund-Fund Balance an approximate amount of \$171,623.55 for the bank stabilization and gravel for the driveway starting from Toestring Road back to the North parking lot for the ARC/Boat Ramp at Toestring Road.


Motion Carried

Motion was made by Commissioner Jenkins, and seconded by Vice Mayor Murphy to allocate \$162,500 from the Water & Sewer Fund Balance for the replacement of the Toestring Road Bridge waterline. The waterline is in critical condition and needs to be replaced under an emergency expense as this line supplies water to approximately 14 residential homes. The estimated cost are \$125,000 for labor and materials and \$37,500 for engineering expenses for a total cost of \$162,500.00.
