The Spring City Scholarship Pageant set for March 5, 2016

The Spring City Scholarship Pageant Committee in conjunction with the Spring City Chamber of Commerce has set the date of March 5 for the 2016 Spring City Scholarship Pageant at the Spring City United Methodist Church Family Life Center.

The Scholarship Pageant is open to young ladies from birth through high school. The new Miss Spring City (high school Juniors and Seniors) will receive a \$1,000 scholarship to be used at the college of her choice and the Jr. Miss Spring City (high school freshmen and sophomores) will receive a \$300 scholarship that may be used for joint enrollment classes at Rhea County High School or at the college of her choice. Young Miss Spring City will be chosen from 5th through 8th graders and Little Miss Spring City will be chosen from 1st through 4th graders. There will also be three divisions of newborn through kindergarten that will take place at 10 a.m. on pageant day with the 4 school age divisions starting at 6 p.m. in the evening.

Deadline for Applications is February 25

Also, the reigning 2015 Royalty will be visiting the Spring City Schools with applications. Box 355, Spring City, TN 37381 to arrive before deadline date of February 25.

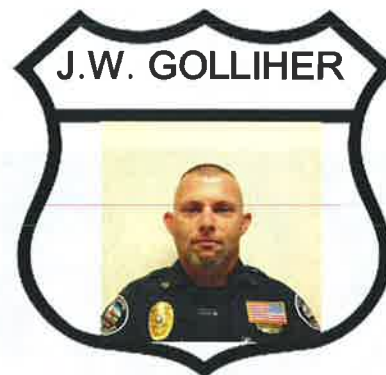
