Phase I of the Veteran's Lakeside Greenway project will work to converting an old highway bed to a multiple use trail. The project will construct 11,610 square feet of ADA compliant slip resistant trail from an existing trailhead (Veteran's Park Walking Trail) to the parking lot of the boat launch near the Dixie Youth Fields. The project will also include the installation of ramps to the pedestrian bridge to allow for ADA accessibility to the path.




