With spring arriving, many residents are trimming trees and asking the city to pick up the brush. You must call City Hall to be added to the brush pick-up list. East side of town is picked up on the second Tuesday of the month and West side is picked up the fourth Tuesday. Our Ordinance (#2008-07) defines brush as tree limbs that are cut to a length that can be handled by one (1) person without mechanical assistance. And further defines reasonable quantities of brush as two (2) cubic yards or less that will be picked up for free. However, any quantities more than that will be charged a fee of not less than \$5.00.

We've noticed that many brush pick-ups are over the specified limit per city ordinance. To simplify, 2 cubic yards is approximately the size of a small pickup truck bed. However, since that normally takes more than one (1) person without mechanical assistance to handle we will charge \$5.00 per additional employee that it takes to handle that one load and \$5.00 per employee for each additional load. Sign Permits: With the exception of "For Sale" or "For Rent" signs and nameplates indicating name and house number, all new signs whether permanent or temporary must have a sign permit which shall be issued by the Town of Spring City.

Building Permits: No building or structure shall be erected and no existing building or structure or part thereof shall be reconstructed, moved, or altered; nor shall any land, structure, or building be used except in conformity with the Town of Spring City's zoning regulations specified for the district in which it is located. A building permit is needed in all cases. Please come to City Hall to obtain a building permit and zoning regulations for your district prior to making any changes to your property.
