

RESOLUTION 2024-01

A RESOLUTION THAT THE TOWN OF SPRING CITY IS REQUESTING THAT THE RHEA COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION HOLD A 2024 CITY ELECTION TO FILL THREE EXPIRING SEATS ON THE SPRING CITY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FOR A FOUR YEAR TERM.

WHEREAS, three seats on the Spring City Board of Commissioners are expiring and are up for election in 2024; one (1) of which is the elected Mayor's seat, and two (2) of which are Commission seats, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1-105 of the Charter of the Town of Spring City, city elections are to be held on even numbered years in conjunction with the County General Election to fill any expiring terms;

WHEREAS, for the 2024 City Election, those candidates seeking election as Mayor on the Board of Commissioners must declare his or her intention for that position ONLY. The Mayor selected by popular vote shall have the same powers and duties as a Mayor chosen by the Board of Commissioners. Anyone seeking the position of Commissioner shall declare his or her intention to seek a Commission seat ONLY, and;

WHEREAS, the candidates seeking election to serve on the Spring City Board of Commission as Mayor will serve a four (4) year term and will fill one (1) of the three (3) Commission seats available. The candidates seeking election to the Board of Commission as Commissioner who receive the highest and second highest number of votes shall fill these vacant seats and shall each serve a four (4) year term. This will fill the two (2) remaining Commission seats;

WHEREAS, the Rhea County Election Commission will be conducting the County General Election on August 1, 2024 and the Spring City Board of Commissioners requests that the Election Commission hold a city election to fill expiring seats for the three expiring seats, and;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Town of Spring City, Tennessee Board of Commissioners to request that the Rhea County Election Commission hold a city election to fill the position of Mayor (1) and two (2) Commission seats for a total of three Commission seats in conjunction with the County General Election to be held on August 1, 2024.
