

RESOLUTION NO. R-2026-47

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF SPRING CITY, TENNESSEE, AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURES TO THROUGH TRAFFIC FOR HALLOWEEN ON OCTOBER 31, 2026

WHEREAS, the Town of Spring City desires to provide a safe environment for children, families, residents, and visitors participating in Halloween activities; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commissioners find that temporary street closures to through motor vehicle traffic are necessary to protect pedestrians and promote public safety;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Commissioners of the Town of Spring City, Tennessee, as follows:

SECTION 1. On Saturday, October 31, 2026, from 5:30 p.m. until 9:00 p.m., the following street segments shall be closed to through motor vehicle traffic: West Jackson Avenue from Neal Street to Wassom Memorial Highway; West Rhea Avenue from Neal Street to Wassom Memorial Highway; Piccadilly Avenue from Neal Street to Wassom Memorial Highway; Clinton Avenue between Church Street and Pierce Street; McGoffin Avenue from the Rhea County Rescue Squad facility at 260 McGoffin Avenue to the cul-de-sac; and all intersecting streets located within these closure areas.

SECTION 2. The closures apply only to through motor vehicle traffic. Reasonable access shall be maintained for residents, businesses, emergency vehicles, and other authorized vehicles when conditions permit.

SECTION 3. The Spring City Police Department and Public Works Department are authorized to place barricades and signs, establish traffic-control measures, and adjust barricade locations as necessary for public safety and emergency access.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
