

RESOLUTION NO. R-2026-3

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF SPRING CITY, TENNESSEE, REQUESTING
THE RHEA COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION TO CONDUCT THE 2026
MUNICIPAL ELECTION FOR TWO (2) COMMISSIONER SEATS**

WHEREAS, the Town of Spring City has two (2) Board of Commissioner seats that will expire in 2026 and therefore must be filled through the next regularly scheduled municipal election; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Tennessee law, municipal elections for expiring terms of office are administered by the Rhea County Election Commission on the election calendar established under state statute; and

WHEREAS, individuals seeking to qualify as candidates for the Spring City Board of Commissioners must meet all state and local requirements, file the appropriate petitions with the Rhea County Election Commission, and comply with all qualifying deadlines; and

WHEREAS, the two (2) Commissioner positions to be elected in 2026 will each serve a term of four (4) years in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the Town of Spring City..



That the Rhea County Election Commission is hereby requested to conduct the 2026 Municipal Election for the purpose of electing two (2) Commissioners to the Spring City Board of Commissioners, each to serve a four-year term.
