

**RESOLUTION NO. R-2026-7**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING A RAILCAM PROJECT AT THE DEPOT BUILDING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AGREEMENTS**

WHEREAS, the Town of Spring City leases and operates the Depot building for public and tourism-related purposes; and

WHEREAS, SouthWest RailCams has proposed installation of rail camera equipment at the Depot building to livestream rail activity; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission finds that the rail camera project serves a public purpose by promoting tourism, community visibility, and economic development;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SPRING CITY, TENNESSEE, THAT:

1. The Town Commission approves participation in a rail camera project at the Depot building.
2. Town staff are authorized and directed to install the rail camera equipment provided by SouthWest RailCams. Limited use of Town facilities, utilities, and internet is approved, subject to a written agreement.
3. The Mayor is authorized to negotiate and execute a memorandum of understanding or similar agreement governing the rail camera project.
4. The Town shall have no responsibility for operation, content, or monetization of the rail camera and may terminate participation at any time.
5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
