**A RESOLUTION FOR THE CUMBERLAND TRAIL CONNECTOR
ARCHITECTURE & ENGINEERING (A&E) AND
CONSTRUCTION, ENGINEERING AND INSPECTION (CEI)**

WHEREAS, the Town of Spring City has received grant funds from the Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC), TN Economic and Community Development, Community Development Block Grant Program (TN-ECD-CDBG) and the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation, Local Parks and Recreation Fund (TDEC-LPRF) that are stated to provide matching funds as coexisting grants. The funds are stated to construct approximately 2.3 to 2.68 miles of recreational trail that are intended to connect Veterans Park, Spring City Elementary, Downtown Spring City and Spring City Nature Park and other natural areas to the Cumberland Trail. The trail will cross under or over U.S. 27 and the accompanying active railroad as well as an approximately 200-foot-long multi abutment pedestrian bridge over the Piney River. The trail surface is to include the options but not limited to natural surface, on road greenway and crushed stone surface.

WHEREAS, the Town of Spring City has received the funds from the aforementioned agencies and intends to maintain the project schedule, FARMER | MORGAN, INC. was selected to undertake the Architectural and Engineering (A&E) and the Construction Phase – Construction, Engineering and Inspection (CEI) for the trail project.

WHEREAS, engineers have a total grant budget not to exceed a project cost of \$2,965,300.00; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the Town of Spring City, Tennessee that the Council authorizes the mayor to execute the architecture and engineering (A&E) contract in the amount of \$330,611.54 and the Construction, Engineering and Inspection (CEI) contract in the amount of \$330,611.54 and Spring City is committed to provide a zero percent (0%) match of the grant based on the grant documentation.
