

RESOLUTION NO. R-2026-16

A RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN PUBLIC WORKS EQUIPMENT AS SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING ITS DISPOSITION THROUGH ONLINE AUCTION (GOVDEALS.COM)

WHEREAS, the Town of Spring City, Tennessee ("Town") owns certain Public Works equipment that is no longer needed for municipal purposes and/or is obsolete, uneconomical to repair, or otherwise not in the Town's best interest to retain; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commissioners find it is in the best interest of the Town to declare this equipment surplus and authorize its disposal in accordance with applicable Town procedures and Tennessee law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Commissioners of the Town of Spring City, Tennessee, as follows:

Section 1. Declaration of Surplus. The Town Commissioners hereby declare the following Public Works equipment to be surplus property:

1. DeWalt battery tools
2. Bosch battery tools
3. Karcher steam/pressure washer
4. Insight Vision camera
5. Hammerhead 900SX floor sweep
6. Sunmax floor sweep
7. Bobcat HB980 jackhammer
8. Forty-nine (49) Badger meters
9. Two (2) job boxes
10. Dynapac CC M2 roller
11. Three (3) STIHL FS90
12. STIHL KM91R edger
13. STIHL BR420C blower
14. Husqvarna 122HD45

Section 2. Authorization to Dispose via GovDeals. Town Staff (including the Public Works Director or designee) are hereby authorized to dispose of the surplus property listed in Section 1 through GovDeals.com (online auction) or another lawful online auction method in the Town's best interest, and to execute any documents reasonably necessary to complete the disposition. Unless otherwise approved by the Town Commissioners, all items shall be sold as-is, where-is, with no warranties expressed or implied. Town Staff is further authorized to set reasonable minimum bids and/or reserve prices, to group items into lots as appropriate, to re-list items that do not sell, and to accept the highest responsible bid when, in the judgment of the Town Staff, it is in the Town's best interest.

Section 3. Records and Proceeds. The Public Works Director (or designee) shall maintain an inventory record of the surplus items disposed of, including the method of disposition and proceeds received. Any proceeds shall be receipted and deposited in accordance with Town financial procedures.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
