

RESOLUTION NO. R-2026-25

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PRELIMINARY DESIGN, PERMITTING, AND REGULATORY REVIEW FOR A PROPOSED FLAGPOLE PROJECT AT THE SPRING CITY NATURE PARK

WHEREAS, the Town of Spring City, Tennessee, desires to determine the feasibility, regulatory requirements, and probable cost of a proposed flagpole project at the Spring City Nature Park;

WHEREAS, in order to pursue review by the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) under Section 26a and any required notice to, or review by, the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), the Town must first obtain a conceptual design and preliminary site plan sufficient for submission to those agencies;

WHEREAS, the Town Commissioners find it appropriate to authorize the preliminary design, permitting assistance, regulatory review, and related expenditures necessary to determine whether the proposed project is possible and to identify the likely total project cost; and

WHEREAS, any further action, including final engineering, bid documents, fundraising for construction, bidding the project, or construction award, shall be considered separately by the Town Commissioners after this preliminary phase is completed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Commissioners of the Town of Spring City, Tennessee, as follows:

SECTION 1. PRELIMINARY PHASE AUTHORIZED. Town staff is hereby authorized to proceed with the preliminary phase of review for the proposed flagpole project at the Spring City Nature Park.

SECTION 2. PRELIMINARY DESIGN AND PERMITTING SERVICES. The City Manager is hereby authorized to engage Barge Design Solutions, Inc. to prepare the conceptual design and related preliminary materials necessary to support Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) Section 26a review, Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) notice or review, and preliminary cost development, in an amount not to exceed Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00), subject to available Funds.

SECTION 3. PERMIT AND REVIEW COSTS. The Town Commissioners hereby authorize payment of the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) Section 26a application fee in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), together with any reasonable Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) filing or related review costs necessary for this preliminary phase, subject to applicable purchasing requirements and available funds.

SECTION 4. LIMITATION OF APPROVAL. This Resolution authorizes only the preliminary design, permitting, and regulatory review described herein. It does not approve the project for construction, final engineering or bid documents, bidding, construction approval, or fundraising for construction. Any such action shall require separate approval by the Town Commissioners after staff reports back on feasibility, regulatory response, and estimated project cost.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
