

RESOLUTION NO. R-2026-25

A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO CERTAIN NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS  
PURSUANT TO T.C.A. § 6-54-111

WHEREAS, T.C.A. § 6-54-111 authorizes municipalities to appropriate funds to nonprofit charitable organizations when the appropriation serves a public purpose and the general welfare of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Spring City desires to appropriate funds in the 2026-2027 fiscal year budget to support certain nonprofit organizations providing services that benefit the Town and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commissioners find that appropriations for early childhood literacy, senior services, economic development, and animal shelter services each serve a valid public purpose and benefit the residents of Spring City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Commissioners of the Town of Spring City, Tennessee:

SECTION 1. The Town hereby appropriates \$1,500.00 to United Way of Rhea County for the Dolly Parton's Imagination Library, subject to funding in the Town's 2026-2027 fiscal year budget.

SECTION 2. The Town hereby appropriates \$1,000.00 to the Senior Lighthouse Center of Spring City, subject to funding in the Town's 2026-2027 fiscal year budget.

SECTION 3. The Town hereby appropriates \$5,000.00 to Rhea Economic & Tourism Council, Inc., subject to funding in the Town's 2026-2027 fiscal year budget.

SECTION 5. The Town Commissioners find these appropriations serve valid public purposes by supporting early childhood literacy, senior services, economic development, and animal shelter services benefiting the residents of Spring City.

SECTION 6. As a condition of receiving these funds, each recipient shall provide any required documentation, use the funds only for the stated public purpose, and provide an accounting upon request sufficient to satisfy applicable audit requirements.

SECTION 7. The City Recorder is authorized to issue payment upon adoption of the 2026-2027 fiscal year budget and receipt of appropriate documentation.

SECTION 8. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption, the public welfare requiring it. ADOPTED by the Town Commissioners of the Town of Spring City, Tennessee, on this 7th day of May, 2026.
