

RESOLUTION NO. R-2026-27

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF SPRING CITY, TENNESSEE,
APPROVING A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT FOR OLD TIME
RESIDENTS FOR A JULY 4, 2026 COMMUNITY FIREWORKS EVENT

WHEREAS, Old Time Residents submitted a Special Event Permit application for a July 4, 2026 community fireworks event; and

WHEREAS, the application reflects a residents' Fourth of July gathering including fireworks, picnic activities, and food vendor(s), with no parade or street closure requested; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commissioners find that the event may be approved subject to compliance with all applicable permit requirements and departmental coordination;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Commissioners of the Town of Spring City, Tennessee, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Special Event Permit application submitted by Old Time Residents for a July 4, 2026 community event is hereby approved.


SECTION 2. This approval is conditioned upon the applicant's compliance with all applicable permit requirements, including insurance, public safety, sanitation, and coordination with the appropriate Town departments.

SECTION 3. The Mayor, City Manager, City Recorder, and other appropriate Town officials are authorized to execute any documents necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
