

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-30

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF SPRING CITY, TENNESSEE, APPROVING A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT FOR THE TENNESSEE AQUARIUM CONSERVATION INSTITUTE FOR LAUREL DACE DAY

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Aquarium Conservation Institute submitted a Special Event Permit application for Laurel Dace Day to be held on May 16, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the application describes a community fundraising and awareness event including a 10k race, a 5k race, a one-mile fun run, music, and vendors; and

WHEREAS, the application requests temporary street closures from approximately 7:30 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. on Front Street from the Nature Park to Clinton Avenue, Clinton Avenue to Pierce Street, Pierce Street to West Rhea Avenue, and West Rhea Avenue to West Jackson Avenue; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Commissioners of the Town of Spring City, Tennessee, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Special Event Permit application submitted by the Tennessee Aquarium Conservation Institute for Laurel Dace Day to be held on May 16, 2026, is hereby approved, including temporary street closures from approximately 7:30 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. on Front Street from the Nature Park to Clinton Avenue, Clinton Avenue to Pierce Street, Pierce Street to West Rhea Avenue, and West Rhea Avenue to West Jackson Avenue.

SECTION 2. This approval is conditioned upon the applicant's compliance with all applicable permit requirements, including insurance, traffic control, public safety, cleanup, and coordination with the appropriate Town departments.

SECTION 3. The Mayor, City Manager, City Recorder, and other appropriate Town officials are authorized to execute any documents necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
