

RESOLUTION NO. R-2026-34

**A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR THE USE OF FRONT STREET BETWEEN
PICCADILLY AVENUE AND WEST RHEA AVENUE FOR APPROVED FESTIVALS AND PUBLIC
EVENTS**

WHEREAS, the Town of Spring City supports festivals and public events that promote community activity, tourism, downtown businesses, and public enjoyment; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commissioners have discussed the use of Front Street, Nature Park, Veterans Park, and other public areas for festivals and public events; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commissioners approve special event permits and related street closures on a case-by-case basis; and

WHEREAS, the Spring City Municipal Code recognizes the Town's authority to close or barricade streets for lawful purposes; and

WHEREAS, after discussion, the Town Commissioners desire to express their support for Front Street, from Piccadilly Avenue to West Rhea Avenue, as the preferred street closure area for approved downtown festivals and public events, unless otherwise approved for a specific event.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Commissioners of the Town of Spring City, Tennessee:

SECTION 1. The Town Commissioners hereby express their support for Front Street, from Piccadilly Avenue to West Rhea Avenue, as the preferred closure area for approved festivals and public events involving Front Street.

SECTION 2. This Resolution does not grant automatic approval for any future event or street closure. All events and related street closures shall remain subject to the Town's special event permit process and approval by the Town Commissioners when required.

SECTION 3. Town staff are authorized to coordinate traffic control, barricades, emergency access, public safety, sanitation, and other operational needs for approved events consistent with this Resolution.

SECTION 4. The Town Commissioners may approve a different closure area, partial closure, or event location, including Nature Park or Veterans Park, when appropriate for a specific event.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
