

ORDINANCE NO. O-2026-8

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF SPRING CITY, TENNESSEE, RESTRICTING THROUGH TRUCK TRAFFIC ON PICCADILLY AVENUE

WHEREAS, the Town of Spring City has authority to regulate traffic on municipal streets under its jurisdiction for the protection of the public health, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, Piccadilly Avenue is a municipal street located within the Town of Spring City and is used for residential and local traffic; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners finds that through truck traffic on Piccadilly Avenue may create safety concerns, increase wear on the street, and create conflicts with residential traffic; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desires to restrict through truck traffic on Piccadilly Avenue while allowing local deliveries, emergency vehicles, utility vehicles, municipal vehicles, sanitation vehicles, school buses, and vehicles serving property on or directly accessed from Piccadilly Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF SPRING CITY, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. No truck, truck tractor, tractor-trailer, semi-trailer, commercial vehicle, or other vehicle with a gross vehicle weight rating over ten thousand (10,000) pounds shall use Piccadilly Avenue as a through route.

SECTION 2. For purposes of this Ordinance, "through truck traffic" means truck or commercial vehicle traffic using Piccadilly Avenue without an origin, destination, delivery, pickup, service call, loading, unloading, or other lawful business purpose on Piccadilly Avenue or property directly accessed from Piccadilly Avenue.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall not apply to emergency vehicles, law enforcement vehicles, fire department vehicles, ambulances, municipal vehicles, utility vehicles, sanitation vehicles, school buses, vehicles making local deliveries or pickups, vehicles providing fuel, propane, repair, construction, moving, or other lawful service to property on or directly accessed from Piccadilly Avenue, or vehicles otherwise authorized by the Town.

SECTION 4. The Town shall post appropriate traffic-control signs giving notice of this restriction. The signs may state "No Through Trucks - Local Deliveries Only" or similar language approved by the City Manager, Public Works Director, or Police Chief. Signs shall be installed in accordance with applicable traffic-control standards.

SECTION 5. The Spring City Police Department is authorized to enforce this Ordinance. A violation of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a civil penalty of up to fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each offense, together with court costs where applicable.

SECTION 6. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is held invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

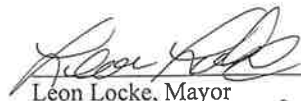
SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage, the public welfare requiring it.

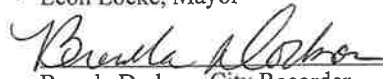
