

ORDINANCE NO. O-2026-9

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE TOWN OF SPRING CITY WATER AND WASTEWATER FEE SCHEDULE TO ADD A FIRELINE TAP FEE

WHEREAS, the Town of Spring City has adopted a water and wastewater fee schedule establishing tap fees and System Development Charges for connections to the municipal water system; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission finds it necessary and appropriate to establish a specific tap fee applicable to fireline connections used for fire protection purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission desires to adopt a fireline tap fee schedule in order to ensure proper cost recovery and proper administration of the municipal water system;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SPRING CITY, TENNESSEE, THAT:

SECTION 1 Fee Schedule Amendment. The Town of Spring City Water and Wastewater Fee Schedule is hereby amended to add a Fireline Tap Fee as a new fee category.

SECTION 2. Fireline Tap Fee Schedule. Fireline taps shall be assessed fees based on fireline size as set forth below:

Fireline Size (Inches)	Fireline Tap Fee
1 inch	\$3,000
1 1/2 inch	\$3,500
2 inch	\$4,000
3 inch	\$5,000
4 inch	\$6,000
6 inch	\$7,000

SECTION 3. Meter Cost and Approval. In addition to the Fireline Tap Fee, the customer shall be responsible for the full cost of the fireline meter, including purchase, testing, and any required backflow systems or additional accessories. All fireline meters must be reviewed and approved by the Town of Spring City prior to installation.

SECTION 4. Installation Costs. In addition to the Fireline Tap Fee and meter cost, the customer shall be responsible for all actual costs associated with installation, including labor, materials, equipment, and required connections to the water main.

SECTION 5. Use Restriction. Fireline taps are for fire protection purposes only and shall not be used for domestic or commercial water consumption.

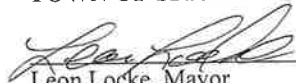
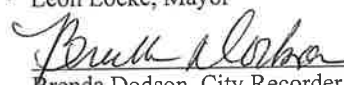
SECTION 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and shall be incorporated into the Town's official fee schedule.

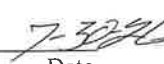

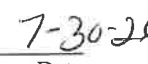
Passed on second and final reading this 30th day of July, 2026.
