**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AUDREY PACK MEMORIAL LIBRARY TO
APPLY FOR PROJECT HOMETOWN HELP FUNDING**

WHEREAS, the Audrey Pack Memorial Library desires to apply for Project Hometown Help funding from Middle Tennessee Natural Gas; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commissioners find that applying for grant funding to support homeschool science instruction, including curriculum, lab supplies, protective eyewear, safety supplies, experiment materials, and a microscope, is in the public interest.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSIONERS OF THE
TOWN OF SPRING CITY, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. The Audrey Pack Memorial Library is hereby authorized to apply for Project Hometown Help funding from Middle Tennessee Natural Gas for a science instruction program for community homeschool families.

SECTION 2. The Mayor, City Manager, City Recorder, Library Director, and other appropriate officials are authorized to execute any documents necessary to submit the grant application.

SECTION 3. This Resolution authorizes application for the grant only and does not obligate the Town to accept grant funds, provide matching funds, or incur any expenditure unless separately approved as required.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
